

I am unaware of any additional forward movement on the Federal bills that CORE has been tracking related to residential care of children.



During the previous month, Paris Hilton and representatives from the Senate and the House were in the news promoting a bill that would end abusive treatment for residents in congregate care settings. Reportedly, the legislation that is yet to be filed includes a bill of rights for children.

The press release associated to Hilton's legislative advocacy described the target as "The Troubled Teen Industry" - "a network of mostly unregulated abusive congregate care facilities for young people that use 'tough love' and other non-evidenced based therapeutic services, schooling and shelter."

No legislation was filed last month, but supporters for the cause indicated they would file the legislation when the timing is right.

Children Continue To Die Following Reports of Abuse/Neglect

Once again, the state of Illinois made the news in June concerning the number of child deaths occurring in homes previously investigated for child abuse or neglect.

A news release entitled: "DCFS timeline shows agency visited family one day before 8-year-old's death" written by Beth Hundsdorfer, Capitol News Illinois, dated June 7, 2022, highlights the shortcomings of DCFS and identifies the deaths of six children as well as highlighting a myriad of other concerning issues.

Catherine Hershey Award Educator of the Year: To honor and reward outstanding educators for the quality of their teaching, their professional leadership, their engagement with families and the community, and their potential for even greater contributions to the healthy development of children.

Catherine Hershey Award Alumnus of the Year: An alumnus who shows outstanding commitment to his/her alma mater. This alumnus gives back to his/her program/school through a variety of means, such as mentorship of current students, help with fundraising, or showing his/her dedication to the program/school in other ways. This alumnus serves as an exemplary role model.

CORE Member Trustee Member of the Year: A CORE member program/school's trustee who demonstrates a commitment to a member's program/school by maximiz-

ing his/her talents, skills, and connections to benefit the program/school. Trustee goes beyond the basic requirements

CORE Policymaker of the Year: A policymaker at the local, state, or federal level who has gone out of his/her way and effectively advocated for the residential education option for children.
