Helpful Information

You may have learned all you need to know in Kindergarten, but I suspect you have some unanswered questions concerning the 2022 CORE National Conference. I'll attempt to be brief, but let me provide an informational overview.

For those who have registered, let me begin by thanking you for your decision to attend and participate in the 2022 CORE National Conference. For those not yet registered, I hope you will do so. Hopefully, the three days together at Milton Hershey School will provide opportunities to visit and network with peers from other children's homes and residential schools. The program content is eclectic and provides each person the freedom to select two out of three workshop topics grouped in sessions.

Conference Format

Each morning will begin with a General Session anticipated being of interest to the entire group. Following the General Session, the workshop sessions for the remainder of the day are grouped with Choices A, B or C.

During our time together, there will be eight workshop sessions including the A, B or C choices.

Each workshop group is repeated twice. For example, workshop group #1 and workshop group #2 are identical. Each workshop group contains three choices. Choose two of the three sessions that most hold your interest in attending.

Since we did not cap the size of any group for registration, should you arrive to find that the room for your first choice is filled, go immediately to the room for your second choice. Following that session, return to the room for your first choice. It should all even out.

Location of the Conference

The location of the CORE Conference is in Founder's Hall, 800 Meadow Lane, Hershey, PA 17033. Parking will be in lot AA (MHS Security Officers will be on hand to assist with parking on Tuesday, Oct. 11). There will be signage immediately inside of Founder's Hall which will direct attendees to the conference location within the building.

Transportation

A Milton Hershey School bus will pick up attendees staying at the Hershey Lodge, beginning at 7:45 a.m. to transport them to Founder's Hall by 8:00 a.m.
